• Cambridge Program – Two LECHS students will be attending

- GHS will be giving 4 million per year for the next 20 years in Health and Education. Legacy will apply.
- Legacy hosted the SCPCSD Spring Regional meeting April 18; over 50 charter school leaders and district staff visited to learn more about best practices at LCS
- GCSD has notified charter schools transferring to the SCPCSD that graduates will no longer be eligible for JE Sirrine Scholarships. This matter is under review and local charters are considering the clarification from the Office of SC Attorney General (represented charters on the previous appeal to allow participation)
- US Department of Education has made a decision on Legacy's request for Title I support due to growth an expansion. The administration has asked for a decision as soon as possible as the school prepares to transfer to the SCPCSD effective July 1
- The Preschool Feasibility Study is underway and Mr. Crawford and Mr. Brown will be visiting the Apple Tree Charter Preschool in Washington, DC to learn more about the Every Child Ready Program
- Rebranding Legacy Charter as Legacy Early College (ES, MS and HS). Rebranding will be starting soon.
- Elementary library is completed and Office of School Facilities will issue a Certificate of Occupancy this week (the May Board meeting could be held there)
